We are so proud of Region VI and the main reason is because of you the members and their parents. WE HAVE the greatest volunteers and believe me we could not pull these region rodeos off without each and every one of you. We usually have plenty of help and are always looking for more, especially setting up barrels and poles. It takes no past experience to get involved in our region; we will train anyone that is willing to help us. Believe me, the more help we have the quicker and smoother our rodeos run.

Our first rodeo for the season will be the weekend of August 27-28, 2022. You will need to check in between 7:00 and 8:45am. MANDATORY MEETING IN THE STANDS AT 9AM.

CHECK IN – is mandatory for the FIRST RODEO (after that will only be if you are on the Need to See List). You will need to have all your paperwork uploaded into your membership portal prior to the start of the rodeo. You will not be able to participate until correct paperwork is uploaded, if you need help reach out to Anne. At check in, you will receive a rule book, back number, Ford Raffle tickets, Bloomer tickets, Ad Sales Form, and various other important papers from the state and national office.

**MANDATORY MEETING** for every contestant and parents will be in the stands. **Don't worry we will give the barrel racers plenty of time to warm up.** We will be going over all the rules of NHSRA that we feel need to be addressed and we will be introducing the student officers, and student event directors. Nomination for the Student Officer and Event Directors must be completed before August 19, 2022. You will see the nomination QR codes can be found in this package and Facebook. Once nominations have closed, voting will begin on August 22 and will end August 27 at 8:30am. QR codes will be posted on Facebook page and sent out on Remind.

- You will pay NHSRA, TJHSRA and Region Dues on this site.
- Print out your membership application and minors release form (on portal). Fill
  out forms, and have them signed and notarized (I am a notary if you are needing
  help on this).
- Upload the completed form to your portal (if you are having trouble reach out)
- NEED MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND MINORS RELEASE UPLOADED BY AUGUST 15 – SO WE CAN HAVE EVERYTHING ELSE READY FOR YOU AT FIRST RODEO – YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE AT FIRST RODEO IF I DO NOT HAVE THESE PAPERS COMPLETED.
- 4. **Prospective Members Letter** from the state very important TEXAS rules, regarding the requirements that must be met.
  - Ford Raffle Ticket must sell at least 15 tickets (there are incentives for selling more – see Ford Ticket Guidelines)
  - Bloomer Raffle Tickets must sell 3 tickets (great fund raiser for the Region)
  - Ad Program Sales (state requires a \$50 minimum)
- 5. **Donation/Sponsor Letter** it is never too early to start trying to get sponsors! We have been offered a grant of \$20,000 if the region can match that so let's get to work!
  - IF AN EVENT DOES NOT HAVE AT LEAST 10 CONTESTANTS IN THAT EVENT, A SADDLE WILL NOT BE AWARDED. A sponsor would have to sponsor this event for a saddle to be awarded. If a sponsor is not secured the Event Champion will receive a prize – but not a saddle.
- **6. Contestant Contact Form** please use the QR code or online and complete this form, this is for the region to reach out to you at anytime we need to get in touch with you.
- 7. Adult Membership Form please use the QR code or online you may pay by VENMO or at the first rodeo we will have a table set up to pay VENMO @thsra6 or mail to P.O. Box 886, Caldwell 77836

- 8. The state is converting to online entries they are scheduled to go live August 1 (plenty of time to enter if they go live before I will be posting on website, Facebook and Remind) THIS WILL BE THE ONLY WAY TO ENTER A RODEO THIS YEAR YOU MAY PAY WITH CREDIT CARD OR BRING MONEY (cash, check or money order) TO THE RODEO. AFTER THE FIRST DEADLINE OF ENTERING A LATE FEE WILL BE ACCESSED AND YOU WILL NEED TO PAY WITH CREDIT CARD. I realize this will be a learning curve but just think you will be able to enter on your phone! I will be available to help you if you need any help!

- Back Number on your back (will be given at check in)
- Belt is optional

Dress code is a must anytime you are under the covered arena area (this means inside the cyclone fenced area), even if you are just watching in the stands or standing behind the bucking chutes. This is a NHSRA rule, if you are not in full dress code, you may be disqualified.



MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Welcome prospective members to the National and Texas Junior High Rodeo Association. We are pleased to know that you are thinking about becoming a member in this great association where "The Elite Compete". Along with the requirements of the region you are thinking about joining, there are a few the TJHRA requires, and so there will be no misunderstanding as to what these requirements are, they are listed below:

- 1. You must be in good standing, under 16 years of age, and be considered a full-time student with passing grades in 70% of classes taken. Any student attending a **private**, **homeschool**, **year-round school or correspondence school**, must show proof of full-time status (passing 70% of classes) and the grade report must be a professional, computer generated document with the signatures of the teacher(s) for each subject. Any of these types of schools must be a state accredited school/program. If there are any questions, you must get pre-approved **ONE (1) MONTH PRIOR TO DEADLINES** through the TJHRA State Office by calling **979-412-2551** All students, even the ones in public school, will be required to turn in a report card or transcript with their membership application, at mid-term and at the State Finals. Any questionable documents of public, private, home, year-round or correspondence school received at deadline times will result in ineligibility of points for a minimum of two (2) rodeos, until the problem is worked out. **Any documents that are falsified will result in immediate disqualification from the association**.
- 2. You will be required to sell **fifteen (15) Truck Raffle tickets** by December 1, 2022 and have these returned to your region secretary. For every five (5) tickets sold, you will receive one (1) free ticket.
- 3. You will required to sell three (3) \$50 Bloomer Trailer Raffle ticket by December 1, 2022 and have this returned to your region secretary. (Please note some regions may require to sell more.)
- 4. You will also be required to sell at least **one (1) \$50 State Ad** for the TJHRA State Finals program. For any additional ads sold over \$350, the member will receive 25% commission on the additional ad amount and your region will receive 20% commission. The first \$50 is due by December 1, 2022. **ALL ART WORK IS DUE MARCH 1, 2023** TJHRA members selling the most total ads and sponsorships will receive the following awards:

1st place - Trophy saddle (must have a minimum of \$3,000 in ad sales)

2nd place - hand crafted Silver/rawhide breast collar and head stall, unless the member sells over \$3,000 in ads. If your ads total over \$3,000, you will receive a gift certificate for a trophy saddle

3rd place - hand crafted silver/rawhide breast collar

4th place - hand crafted head stall

5th place - deluxe travel bag with hand-tooled leather logo "TJHRA"

We are getting ready to kick off the 2022-2023 year for Region 6! JB Wells would like to thanks you for making us your home another year. We will be doing call-in just like we did last year The phone lines did get on overload so if are not answering give it a minute or two and try again.

### This year we will be opening up the office phone lines for the rodeo season reservations on August 10<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m.

With that said we will <u>NOT</u> be taking <u>ANY</u> reservations until this date and time. Do not leave a message on our answering machine or send us an e-mail to let us know which sites you wish to have. We will only be taking phone calls. Also, we will only allow you to make your own reservations. We are trying to create an equal reservation opportunity for everyone. We will then return your call within a few hours to book your reservations for the year. Keep in mind; we will probably be loaded with calls the first day. Therefore, you may not get a call back right away; give us a day or two.

Finally, it is not mandatory, but we do recommend paying for your reservations in advance. This helps us to have everything unlocked and ready to go for you when you arrive. As in the past we will have someone working until about 9 p.m. on Fridays for your convenience, if you plan to arrive later than that you must have your stalls and hook-ups paid in advance. If you do not have a reservation, do not pull into a hook-up site, as it is more than likely already taken. The same rule applies for stalls, as well. Also make a note of this; we will not be giving any refunds and not rolling anything over from rodeo to rodeo.
